



Post WW1 - 1

Voting rights for (some) women 1918

- Sex Disqualification Act 1919
 - Equal rights despite being married
 - Royal Charters (eg liveries and City)
 - Access to professions eg law
 - Encouraged granting of degrees

Post WW1 -2

- Lady Parsons and City freedom for married women
 - Mistress Shipwright 1922-3 given freedom of company for her work as Mistress
 - Patrimony via women freemen ignored till 1970s

- Equal status and liveries in 1970:
 - 6 Ancient; 4 of 7 Modern open

Civic City and women 1

- Mary Donaldson
 - 1st woman Councilman, Alderman, Sheriff 1981, LM 1983

• Fiona Woolf: Sheriff 2010, LM 2013

Sheriffs: 5 non aldermanic from 1999

Civic City and women 2

• Women on Common Council 37/125.

Aldermanic Court 8/25

- Chief Commoner: 6 since 1987
 - Edwina Coven 1987, Ann Holmes 2023

 - Total restructuring of LM charity
 - City Giving Day
 - What is now the Sheriffs' Ball

Clothworkers (and others) aiming for 50:50

Women in the Livery

• 2 or even 3 women masters in a row

• Livery survey average ≤ 23%

Harassment etc

- A Safer City Elisabeth Mainelli patron, Sara Cork with Ian Dyson
 - Safe havens for women in the City
 - Helping to change culture
 - Learning from focus groups

Women Masters (in brief 1)

• 1983 the first: Sylvia Tutt

12 women appointed more than once

• HRH the Princess Royal – 8 + Saddlers

Dame Fiona Woolf – 4 (Sir David Wootton 6)

Women Masters (in brief 2)

• Still a real minority – 13.3% in last decade,

Total as at October 2024 since 1983 269)
 1.1% 1983-2002 (22 from 1983)

5.51% 2003-2012 (80 from 1983)

18.02% 2023 20/111 (249 total from 1983-2023)
