**Re: The London Accord**

Thank you for meeting me, and colleagues from BERR to explain the work of the London Accord. I'm sorry it has taken us a while to follow up our meeting.

You explained that the London Accord was a co-operative project that releases investment research into the public domain in order to assist public debate, including for policy makers in Government.
